Guided Meditation

I am going to introduce you to a form of meditation,

We are going to nourish the imagination, the mad woman in the house, as St. Teresa says,

We must be very careful in dealing with her not to ruffle her feathers.

Let me invite you to get comfortable and **close your eyes**,

We are approaching **infinite God**:

Like a bird that is learning to fly, allow yourself to be **carried by grace**;

Imagine your body as a **temple**; The **temple of the Holy Spirit**;

Descend within yourself;

Descend further,

Notice your **breathing**. Your breathing is slow and peaceful;

Descend even further,

Notice the **beating of your** heart;

Your heartbeats are the **hand of Christ** knocking on the **door of your heart.**

Descend further;

You see a door in front of you; Go ahead, Open the door.

A **radiant light** streams out through the open door,

There is a **magnificent view** before you,

You can see **mountains** in the far-off distance,

You are standing in a prairie,

It's the **Spring**, the **birds** are singing, the **bees** are buzzing,

You can feel a **gentle breeze** caressing your face and making the tall grass around you sway,

You notice the distinct noise of the wind in the leaves in the trees,

On your left there is a **stream**, you can hear it **gurgling**; you can see the **dance of the light** on the water surface as it rapidly courses along.

Below, on your right, you notice a **flock of sheep**,

You can hear the sheep basing and the **tinkling of their bells**,

Lambs are bleating, calling their mothers to have some milk,

Beyond the flock, stands a **Shepherd**,

He has been there from the beginning; he's been **observing** you,

He is clad all in white,

His dazzling garments reflect his glory and majesty, His name is above all names,

He is holding a **shepherd's staff**,

He begins to **come towards** you,

You feel like a gazelle or a young fawn jumping for joy!

It seems like **you know him** without ever having seen him,

He is getting nearer, the **earth trembles under his footsteps**, your heart trembles too, because **HE KNOWS**,

You feel **free** as the birds in the air,

He is **even closer**; He is **so close** now that you can almost **touch him**,

A flame bursts forth within you; it becomes a column of fire that rises and enflames the world

COMMENTARY

This is a very simple way,

God is waiting for us in our **deepest self**, he is always there,

To situate yourself, your position is important---to your **left** is a stream.

To your **right** a flock of sheep—a flock--- you are **not alone**,

Whatever happens we are not alone in silent prayer, remember all the **other sheep throughout the world**,

The **Supreme Shepherd** watches over each one of his sheep and has a **relationship** with each one individually as if it were the only one,

He is the **only one** who can fully **love in general and specifically,**

The column of fire is vertical, it rises to heaven and enflames the world. This is very important, it is the image of the cross,

The cross is planted in the earth and **points to heaven**,

Transcendence and immanence must always go together,

As long as we are on the earth, we need to keep a foot on the earth and a foot in eternity.

Let me encourage you to devote at least 5 minutes a day to Our Lord, you can start by using this meditation All that goes through your senses will help you to recollect yourself: Gospel of the day, a candle, a holy image, an icon, incense.

TRANSCENDENCE

Only God is transcendent; in being- he alone is infinite and perfect Being who cannot change; in activity-- he alone has existence of himself as uncreated First Cause on whom all creatures depend for their least operation.

DIVINE IMMANENCE
