The Nature of Her Book kk

Teresa's book is not an autobiography; nor is it an intimate diary. What she deals with mainly are the supernatural (infused or mystical) realities of the interior life. Autobiographical material is used as a backdrop against which she outlines the existence and value of the favors of God. The biographical data comprise two levels, on exterior, the other interior. The exterior level deals with the historical facts. The interior level deals almost exclusively with the mystical facts.
